The Responsibilities of a Trenton Rotarian

- Maintain 60% attendance at Freddies or through make-ups at any other club; you are welcome throughout the world! Find local Rotary Clubs for make-ups here: www.trentonrotary.org/locations.htm
- Propose new members it's a privilege and obligation to expand Trenton Rotary with civic minded members. Invite a friend or colleague to a regular meeting, and introduce him or her to the Club Secretary.
- Roll up your sleeves, put "Service Above Self" and participate at least twice a
 year in a Trenton Rotary Service Project.
- Financial commitments include:
 - \$45 in Quarterly dues and \$14 per week for all regularly scheduled luncheon meetings (both billed quarterly)
 - Your full support in both spring and fall fundraising efforts. Each requires you to commit to selling (or buying yourself) approximately \$150 worth of tickets, goodies or other Rotary fundraising items;
 - Support the Rotary International Foundation (\$100 suggested annual giving), billed quarterly at \$25/quarter 100% of funds collected are used for service projects around the world or in our local community.

Getting started in Trenton Rotary

- Use your sponsor and the Membership Committee members.
- Attend a fireside chat/orientation dinner to get more information about Trenton Rotary and our different projects and activities.
- Introduce yourself to other Rotarians by serving as a "greeter" on at least 2 occasions, giving a classification talk, leading the invocation at the beginning of a meeting and sitting at different tables each week at lunch.
- Participate in a committee to help plan or implement a project.
- Experience the broader Rotary community by "making up" at other clubs and attending an event or activity sponsored by our District 7510 or Rotary International.
- Update your personal listing in the Trenton Rotary website; provide a photo or have your picture taken at a weekly Rotary meeting by anyone with a camera phone.
- Display the Object of Rotary and The 4-Way Test at your place of business.
- Visit www.trentonrotary.org, www.rotarynj.org (our District 7510) and www.rotary.org.
- Read The ABCs of Rotary or another Rotary information booklet.
- Listen to the audiotape *Rotary in an Hour*.
